On this page we provided example of two step flow to modify existing customer data using Gastrofix API: external application is loading data of all customers for a specific restaurant chain and then updating details of a specific customer with a new values.

In this tutorial you will be guided through this process and see which API calls will be executed.

1. Get customers info for a specific restaurant chain

The following example shows how you could request customers data for a specific restaurant chain calling our API using curl on the command line.

```
curl -v -X GET --header "Accept: application/json" --header "Authorization: Bearer 6849b523341561e2ac6f09e628ac90fc" "https://api.gastrofix.com/partner/v0.1/customers/1234"
```

2. Update customer data

The following example shows how you could update info for a specific customer calling our API using curl on the command line. To update customer info you are required to put all customer data: both changed and unchanged fields.

```
curl -v -X PUT --header "Content-Type: application/json" --header "Accept: application/json" --header "Authorization: Bearer 6289b923321565e2aa6f69e648ec90ac" -d "{
  \"firstName\" : \"Thomas\",
  \"lastName\" : \"Metzinger\",
  \"description\" : \"Philosopher\",
  \"credit\" : 0,
  <...other info...>
}" "https://api.gastrofix.com/partner/v0.1/customers/1234/a3bdbf25-1e8f-26db-c721-9546e4f7dcef"
```
